## **ATTIRE**

Regalia (cap and gown) and appropriate attire are required. Failure to comply with the Commencement dress code expectations outlined below will result in forfeiture of participation without warning. Attire will be checked and approved prior to the ceremony.

**Royal Regalia** (reserved for students who identify as male): Black dress pants with a white full-sleeve button-down shirt. A tie (necktie or bow tie) must be worn. The tie can be solid or patterned and should be the school's colors (royal and white). Black or brown dress shoes with black socks are required.

White Regalia (reserved for students who identify as female): White or light-colored knee-length formal dress. Avoid a-line dresses or dresses that have especially full skirts, since you will need to zip your gown for the ceremony. Very high heels are not recommended, due to the texture of the field. Shoes should be nude or white. Skintone hosiery may be worn.

Non-binary or gender non-conforming students may wear either white or royal regalia and are to comply with the expectations for royal or white attire outlined above.

Caps and Gowns are not to be decorated or altered in any way for the ceremony. If your cap or gown are altered, you will not be permitted to participate in the ceremony.

Jewelry should be tasteful and not distract from the solemnity of the ceremony.

Purses or bags are not permitted.

The following clothing items will prevent students from participating in the Commencement ceremony, without exception: jeans, shorts, polo shirts, t-shirts, tennis shoes, work boots, white socks, and any clothing items that violate the Dress Code outlined in the SPHS Code of Student Conduct.
